MINUTES OF THE 31st MEETING OF "PROJECT APPROVAL BOARD" OF NATIONAL MISSION ON EDUCATION THROUGH INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY (NMEICT) HELD ON 3rd DEC, 2015 AT 11:00. HRS AT CONFERENCE ROOM, ROOM NO. 112 SHASTRI BHAWAN, NEW DELHI-110 001.

The 31st Meeting of the Empowered Committee of Experts (Project Approval Board (PAB)) of National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (NMEICT) was held on 3rd Dec 2015 At 11:00 Hrs. at Conference Room, Shastri Bhavan, New Delhi, under the Chairpersonship of Secretary, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of HRD.

The list of Members and Invitees who participated in the Meeting is at Annexure-I.

Mission Director (NMEICT) welcomed the Members & Invitees of the PAB and informed them about the Agenda in brief. Thereafter, with the permission of the Chair, the Agenda Items were discussed and the following decisions were taken: -

Agenda Item No. I

Confirmation of the Minutes of 30th PAB the last meeting held on 28th October 2015.

Member Secretary, PAB, invited observations from the Members on the Minutes of the 30th Meeting of the PAB, while the minutes of previous meeting were communicated to all concerned. Since all the Members agreed and no observations on the Minutes were received, the Minutes of the 30th Meeting of the PAB held on 28th October 2015 were confirmed.

Agenda Item No. II

Action Taken Note on the minutes of 29th PAB & 30th PAB meeting held on 20th May 2015 & 28th October 2015 respectively

Member Secretary, PAB placed the Action Taken Report (ATR) regarding the decisions taken during the 29th and 30th Meeting of the PAB held on 20th May and 28th October respectively before the Members. The ATR submitted was noted by the PAB. The PAB decided as under:

- a) Agenda Item no 4 & Agenda Item No 8 of the 28th Meeting: The PAB instructed the TEL Bureau, a letter from Education Secretary, HE to Secretary, DOS requesting for 10 satellites transponder be sent immediately, if not sent so far.
- b) Agenda IV (A) 3: Against delegation of financial power, it was suggested to resubmit the file for necessary action.
- c) Agenda IV (A) No. 4: In order to engage an independent agency for review project of 1 crore and above list of such agencies be put up immediately, so that review is completed as soon as possible.
- d) Agenda IV C (2): The TEL bureau to send a communication to all such PIs to re-

submit proposals on 'MOOCs compliance basis' and such proposal be reviewed by the Domain Expert Committee, if not done so far.

- e) Agenda IV C (5): The member's expressed concerned on financial irregularities reported in a project sanctioned to ILLL and suggested the action on this may be completed at the earliest and report submitted to the PAB.
- f) Agenda IV C (11): The PAB felt that there is need to take up skill development project and the Pl be asked to make a presentation during the next PAB.
- g) Agenda IV C (13): The PI of 'Learning by Doing' project should be asked to submit copy of the last PRSG held and the UCs to TEL Bureau, in order to enable it to release the next installment of funds.
- h) Agenda IV C (15): The PAB expressed its concerned that fact-finding has not been initiated to review the complaints against BSNL & MTNL and approved fact finding committee of the following, to submit its report in a month:
 - i) Sr. Officer from Telecom Ministry
 - ii) Director, DeitY
 - iii) Representative from MHRD
- i) Agenda IV C (20): PAB decided the PI be asked to resubmit proposal on 'Distribute digitized answer book evaluation' project and request the PI to make a presentation before DEC (Domain Expert Committee).
- j) Agenda IV C (21): The members were informed; that PI is not working on the project now and has submitted a similar project for approval. It was felt the EduERP is an important proposal and we need to ensure all the elements of the projects are integrated and made workable. A meeting of the PI, with the Addl. Secretary be arranged to resolve the issues on the project, within a month. The members desired that appropriate action may be taken as approved by the 29th PAB.
- k) Agenda IV C (22): The members desired that before the last installment of the project is released to the PI, the file be put up for examination of the IFD.
- 1) Agenda IV C (b) (1): The PAB felt that DTH is an important activity, approved by the Cabinet, which needs to be implement at the earliest. In order to review the merits and limitation, if any of the project, a sub group of the following is constituted: Prof. Timothy A. Gonsalves, Director, IIT Mandi, Prof. R V Raja Kumar, Director, IIT Bhubaneswar and the members and other members of the Committee be recommended by the Addl. Secretary, TEL and the committee submit its report in a month.

Resubmission of proposal on 'Establishment of Hotspot I Wi-Fi Campus Connect at Central Universities' after due diligence.

After considering the report submitted by DG ERNET, and after deliberations, PAB has approved the campus wi-fi project in 38 Central Universities listed here under:

The approval is subject to the following conditions:

- a) The project shall be implemented only in the permanent campuses. Provision of wi-fi in temporary campus is allowed as an exception in the case of CU of Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, and Gujarat, since they are not expected to move into permanent campuses in the next 5 years. In case of CU of Jharkhand, the project shall be implemented only a detailed field study of the existing temporary campus.
- b) The funds sanctioned define the upper limits. Actual release shall be based on the final tender price. However, if the final tender price is more than what has been sanctioned, the University shall meet the funds (over and above the sanctioned funds) from its resources.
- c) Where the grants already released to CUs for this purpose is more than what has been estimated by ERNET, the CU shall use those funds for completing the project as approved by the PAB. The CU Division will issue orders accordingly to those universities.



- d) Wi-fi shall provide only the 'In building' access for the building identified. No Wi-fi shall be provided for open areas.
- e) The project shall be completed by 30th June 2016. No extension in the project would be allowed.
- f) It must be ensured that all active equipment shall have a life-time of at least 5 years and passive equipment of at least 15 years. The industry practices adopted by the BSNL & MTNL shall be followed.
- g) Equipment shall be purchased after following the process laid down in the GFR strictly. Since the project size is large, ERNET should expand he vendor-base after following due process.
- h) The funds released by MHRD or UGC in the past shall be set off against the project cost and only balance funds shall be released from the NME-ICT.
- i) The project would be executed by ERNET as Pl under the overall guidance of an Implementation and Monitoring Committee (IMC) consisting of:
 - i. Prof. R. V. Raja Kumar, Director, IIT Bhubaneswar: Chairman
 - ii. Sr. Officers from Ministry of Telecom, Member
 - iii. Sr. Officer from DeitY, Member
 - iv. Mr. Raju Srinivasan, Director (ICT), Convener

All the decisions about the procurement shall be taken by ERNET after due consideration and approval by the IMC.

- j) Since most of the active equipment has to be imported, funds required for opening the LC shall be released in the first instance, after completing the procurement process. The exemption from customs shall be obtained as per the procedure in vogue.
- k) Administrative cost of 5% is allowed for ERNET on the project.

The PAB approved execution of Campus Wi-Fi project in 38 Central Universities by ERNET as listed above, with total users numbering 2.59 Lakhs, comprising of 1,682 buildings at a total cost of Rs.335,85,39,826.00. It also noted that a sum of Rs.196.78 Cr have already been released by the CU Bureau to (12) CUs, accordingly net amount approved for release is capped at Rs.246,98,47,492.00 only.

Agenda Item No. IV

Considering 'Modalities for execution of the Wi-Fi Project'.

The 30th PAB approved ERNET shall execute the project in totality at 38CU's under the guidance of IMC constituted for this purpose. The project should be completed before June 30, 2016.

Agenda Iwa No. V

Extension for all continuing Projects, from 1st January 2016 till 31st March 2016, without sanction of any additional amount.

The PAB decided that all projects sanctioned so far shall be reviewed by the PRSGs. The PRSGs shall be reconstituted limiting the PRSGs to (9). All the projects shall be distributed among these PRSGs. Each PRSG shall be serviced by a Sr consultant/Consultant/Jr Consultant from NME-ICT. This process of review of the

projects by the PRSGs shall be completed and a report submitted by each PRSG on each of the projects allotted to them on or before 31st January 2016.

Based on these reports, projects which are dormant or falling short of the milestones and failed in achieving the objectives shall be closed; and the balances if any, shall be recouped.

All other projects found to be functioning well shall be allowed to be completed, which shall, in any case, not be beyond 31st March 2016.

Agenda Item No. VI

Ratification of extension offered to NPTEL, CEC and UGC e-content development Projects from 1st January, 2016 till 31st December, 2016.

The PAB was informed that ES, HE in his capacity as Chairman, PAB has extended the projects offered to NPTEL, CEC and UGC e-content development Projects from 1st January 2016 till 31st December 2016 so that the agencies can complete their projects approved by the PAB.

The PAB ratified the extension of NPTEL, CEC and UGC e-content development Projects from 1st January, 2016 till 31st December, 2016.

Agenda Item No. VII

Approval of report by 'Costing Committee; towards the assessment of costing for reappropriation, design, development and operations of MOOCs'

PAB while taking note of the costing committee felt that it would be appropriate that the expenditure on the MOOCs content should be booked to the new budget head created for that purpose, after approval of the same by the SFC.

Agenda Item No. VIII

Approval 'NPTEL Phase-IV Project', on the recommendations of DEC-Content Meeting held on 23rd November 2015.

The members noted the progress made by NPTEL so far and the recommendations of the DEC-content vide its meeting held on 23rd November, 2015 and noted the PI has met the objectives of the project and exceeded the delivered as per DPR and within funds allocated. The PI has further produced and delivered 93 MOOCs courses.

The PAB noted the PI has utilized funds and made deliverables of phase III NPTEL as per sanctions. Besides this the PI has produced and delivered 93 MOOCs. The project stands completed if the PRSG has seen the utilization certificate. The PAB approved the recommendations of the DEC-Content on NPTEL IV and approved a budget Rs.93.00 Crores for the project deliverable for the next 3 years, provided that the content created follows the 4-quadrant pedagogy of MOOCs.

The Deputy Secretary (ICT) thanked the Chairman and all PAB members and invitees for having conducted a fruitful deliberation and discussion of agenda items.
